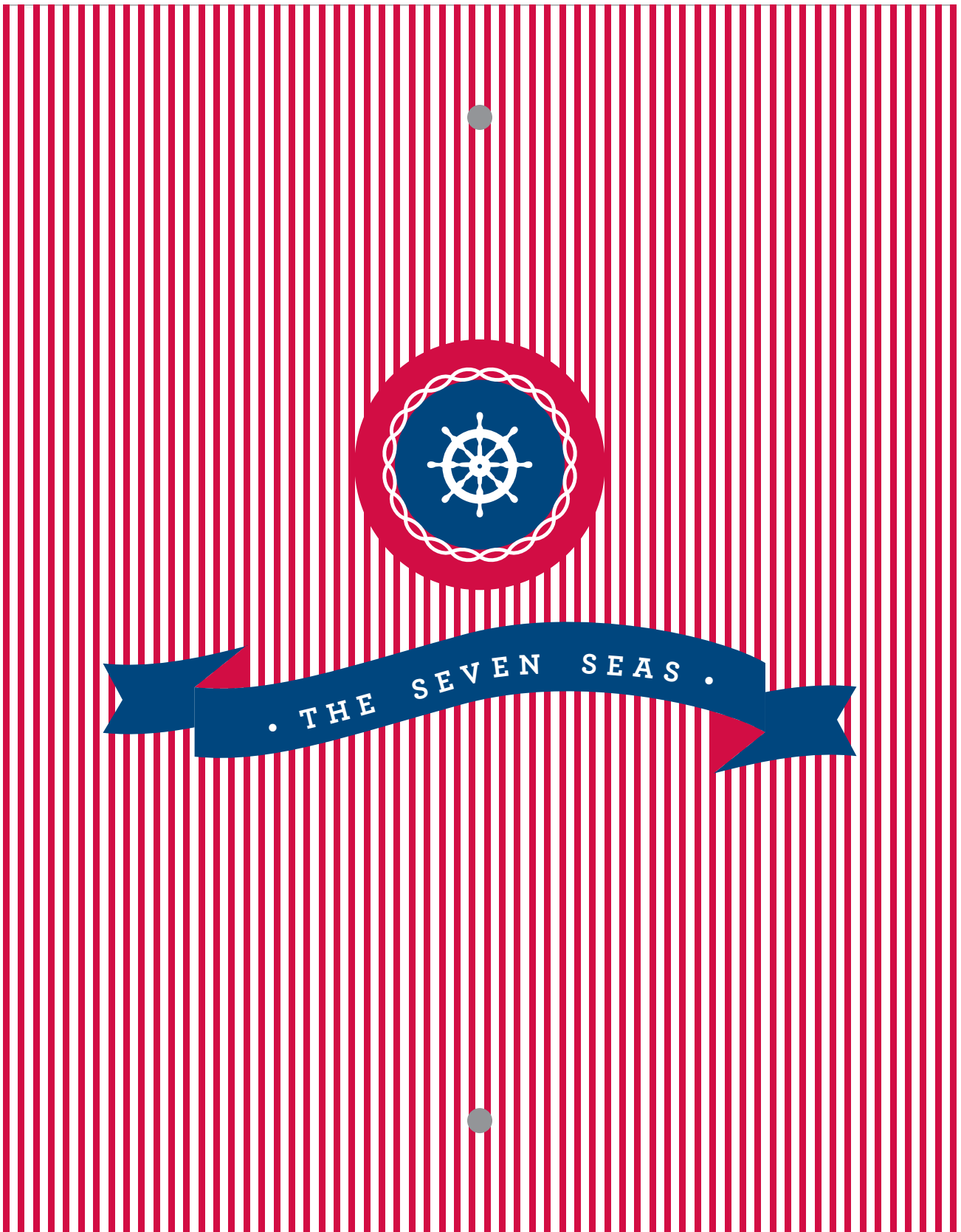

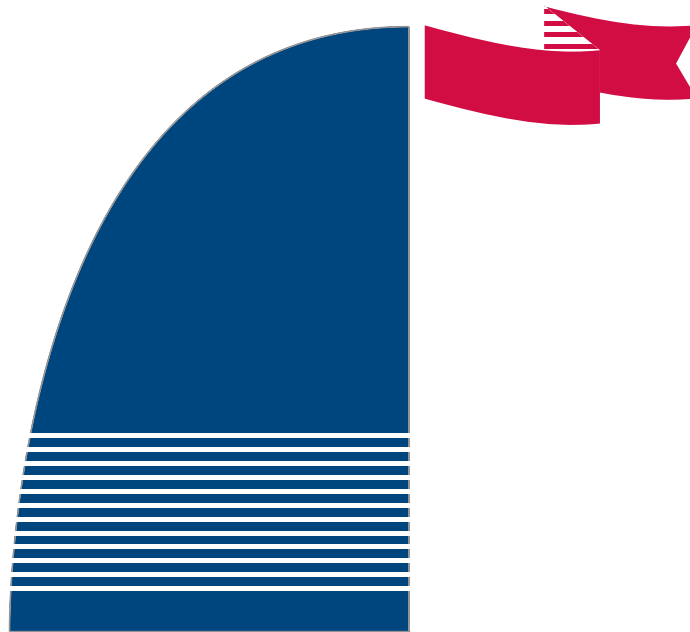
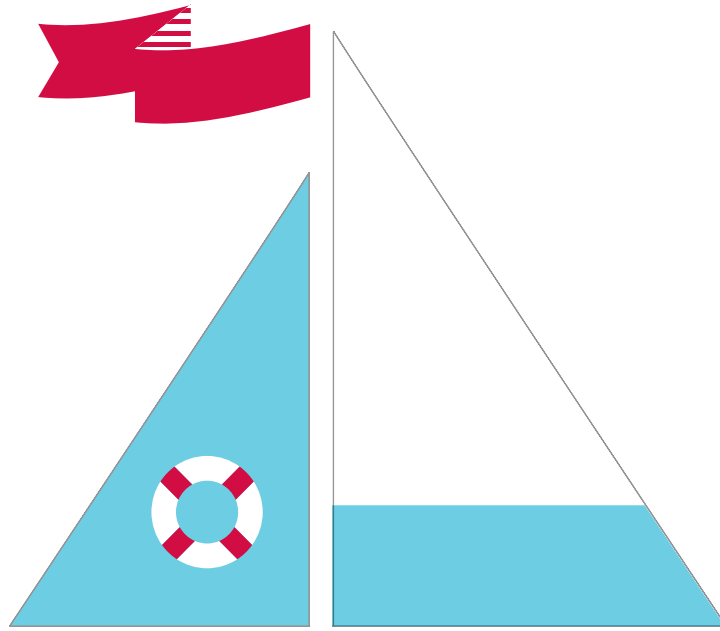
## sail template

(from the sailors party)

**Instructions:**

For the fruit boat bounty (page 80), print this page and use a pair of scissors to cut out the above sail. Use a single hole punch to cut out the the two circles marked in grey. Using a

small wooden dowel or a wooden skewer, thread it through the two holes to form the boat's mast. Tie some twine around the top and bottom of the mast so the sail doesn't come loose.

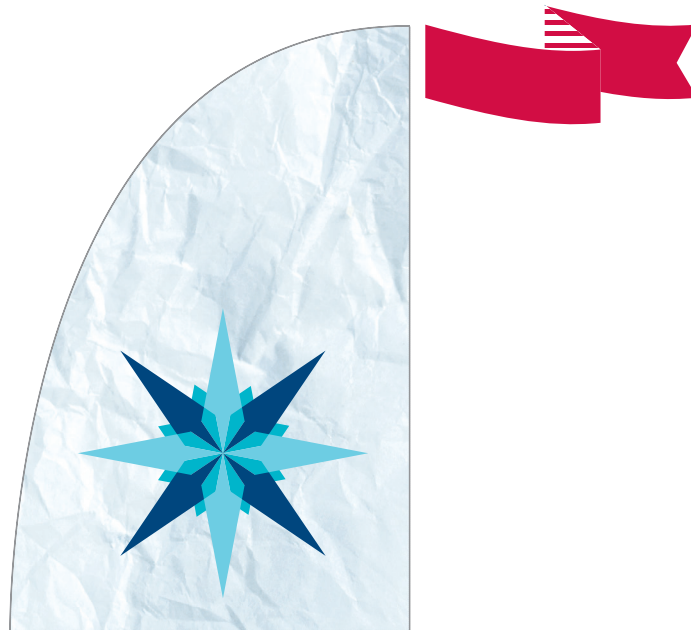
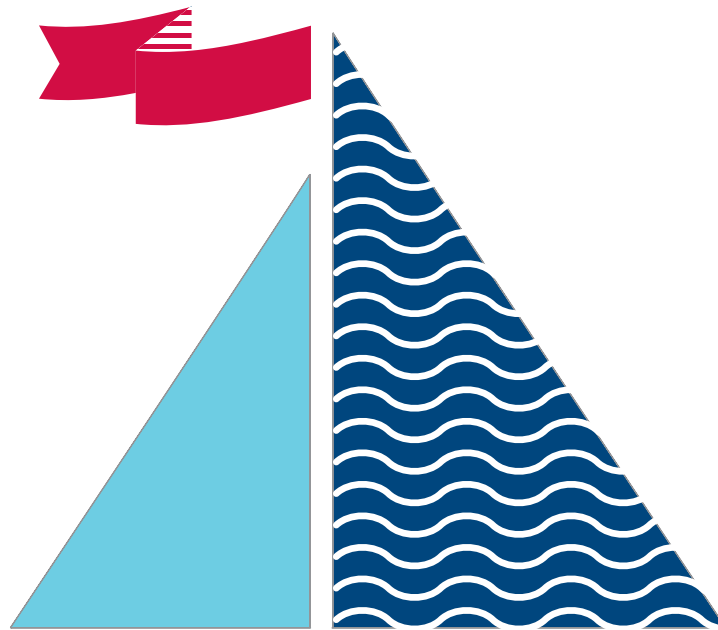


## boat skewer template (from the sailors party)

### Instructions:

For the red velvet sail boat cupcakes (page 86), print this page and use a pair of scissors to carefully cut out each sail (the top sail in two parts), as well as the red flags. For the dark

blue sail, thread a wooden skewer through the top and bottom of the sail to form the mast. Glue the flag to the top of the mast. For the other sail, glue the smaller sail to the front of a wooden skewer and the larger sail to the back. Glue the flag to the top of the mast.

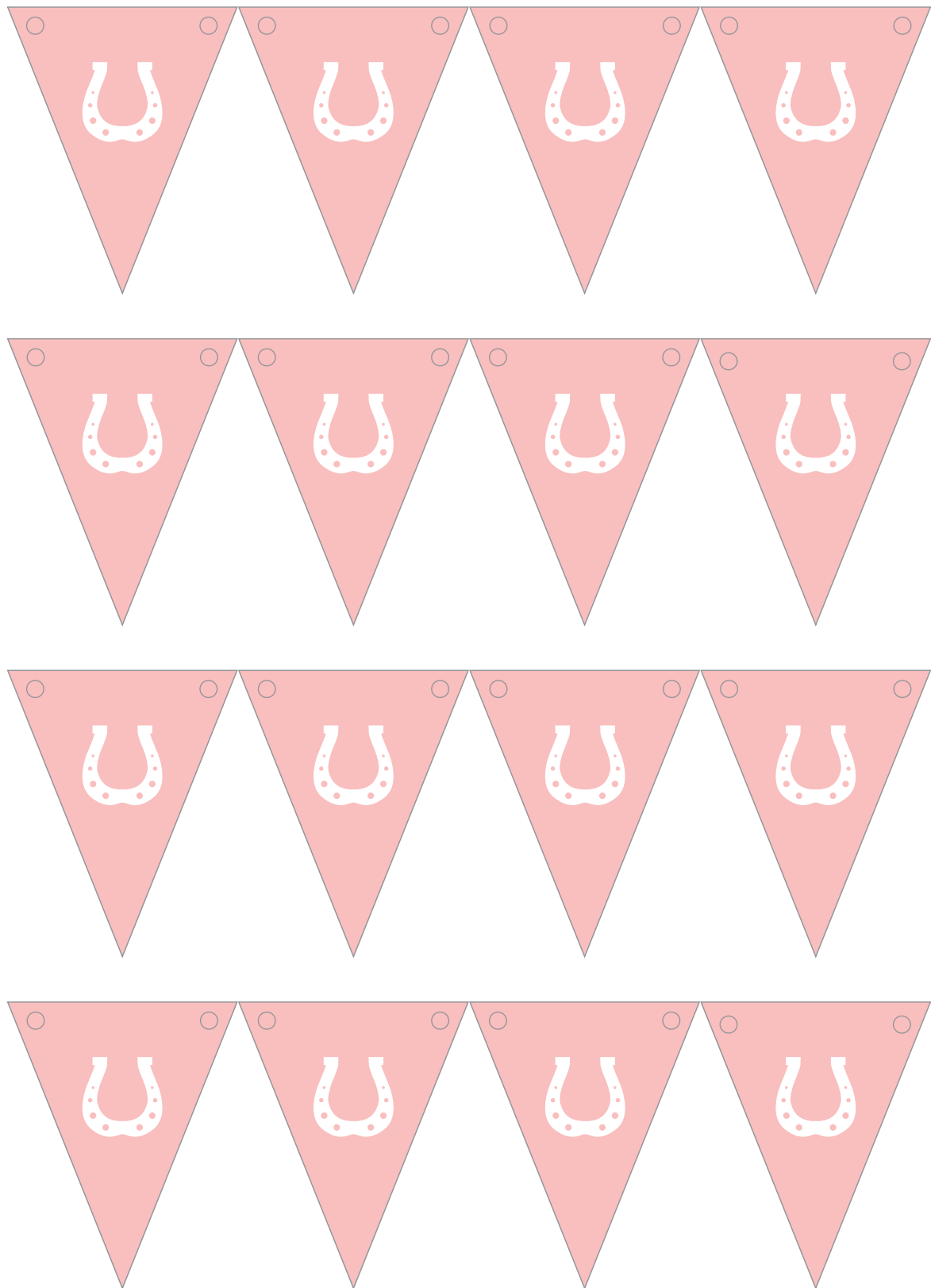


## boat skewer template (from the sailors party)

### Instructions:

For the red velvet sail boat cupcakes (page 86), print this page and use a pair of scissors to carefully cut out each sail (the top sail in two parts), as well as the red flags. For the white

sail, thread a wooden skewer through the top and bottom of the sail to form the mast. Glue the flag to the top of the mast. For the other sail, glue the larger sail to the front of a wooden skewer and the smaller sail to the back. Glue the flag to the top of the mast.



## chocolate layer cake bunting template

(from the pony party)

**Instructions:**

To decorate the cake stand for the chocolate layer cake (page 114), print this page and use a pair of scissors to carefully cut

out the above flags. Using the circles on either side as a guide, punch some holes through the flags and thread them onto some thin twine to form the bunting. Tie this around the bottom of the cake stand to serve.
