We have become aware that the battery in the promotional kitchen timers (pictured), which were distributed as a gift with purchase with donna hay magazine in the April/May 2007, April/May 2011 and limited copies of the August/September 2012 editions, can be easily removed from the battery component. These batteries are harmful if swallowed. What to do Please be careful to keep the timers out of sight and reach of children and consider taping the battery cover to ensure the battery is secure. If you suspect a child has swallowed the battery or placed one in their nose, immediately go to a hospital emergency room. Do not let the child eat or drink and do not induce vomiting. Call the Poisons Information Centre on 13 11 26 for additional treatment information.
